



Tapping Into Crypto x Australian Crypto Convention Giveaway – Rules of Entry

1. These are the terms and conditions and rules of entry (**Rules**) of the Tapping Into Crypto x Australian Crypto Convention Giveaway which is open at **12:00pm AEST on Tuesday 9 August 2022**, with entries closing 48hrs later at **12:00pm AEST on Thursday 11 August 2022**.
2. The promotion is free to enter and is operated by Swyftx Pty Ltd, ABN 72 623 556 730 of Milton QLD 4064.
3. To enter the promotion, applicants must:
 - a. Be over the age of 18;
 - b. Be residents of Australia;
 - c. Listen to [Episode 67 of Tapping into Crypto with Dave Haslop](#);
 - d. Answer the question: **Tell us in 25 words or less, what advice does Dave have for someone getting into crypto?**;
 - e. Submit an answer by replying to the official competition post on the Tapping into Crypto Twitter account during the time the promotion is open; and
 - f. Adhere to all the Rules set out in this document.
4. Winners will be determined on **Thursday 11 August 2022**. The promotion is not a game of chance and entries will be considered in the order they are received.
5. There are a total of 10 prizes to be awarded to 10 winners:
 - a. Each winner will receive:
 - i. 2 x 2-day passes to the Australian Crypto Convention on the Gold Coast, Australia on the 17-18th September 2022. (Accommodation & Travel not included)
6. An applicant can submit one reply as an entry. Subsequent entries by the same applicant under the same Twitter account, on the same round, will be void and disregarded.
7. The judge, being an employee of Swyftx, will review the entries in the order in which they were received and will determine:
 - a. The 10 winners of the competition chosen to have the most informative reply to the question at section 3(d).
8. The judge's decision is final and is not subject to review.
9. Announcements of the winners will take place on **Friday 12 August 2022**, including publication of the winners first name and first initial of last name on the Swyftx [AU](#)

 - b. Will have 2 business days to respond to the email/message request confirming their acceptance of the prize, otherwise, the next runner up winner will be contacted within 1 business day of this 2 business day expiring period;

Will participate in and co-operate as required with all reasonable marketing and editorial activities relating to the promotion, including (but not limited to) being recorded, photographed, filmed or interviewed and acknowledge that Swyftx may use any such marketing and editorial material without further reference or compensation to them.

14. The information collected during this promotion will be dealt with in accordance with our Privacy Policy and Terms of use.
15. Entry is not open to any directors, employees, contractors of Swyftx or their families.
16. These Terms and Conditions may be adjusted if required by regulatory or government authority without notice.
17. Swyftx reserves the right to disqualify entries in the event of non-compliance with these Terms and Conditions. In the event that there is a dispute concerning the conduct of the promotion or claiming a prize, Swyftx will resolve the dispute in direct consultation with the entrant.
